**Bible reading:**

1. Read Galatians 5:1. What is an area of freedom that you need to experience and can experience because of what Jesus has done for you?
2. What does it mean to be free from the law? Does being free from the law mean that you can break the law with no consequences? Is God mad at you when you break His law?
3. Read Galatians 5:13-14. How is it that serving one another in love is an antidote to the indulgences of the sinful nature?
4. Describe how a person 'living by the Spirit' having the heart tank filled with God's love, security, worth and significance, can be less vulnerable to indulging the sinful nature.
