In your Bible this week:

Read one of these passages each day to deepen the impact of the sermon and to prepare for next week. Utilize your Life Journal pages or a notebook, writing down a word, phrase or verse that especially speaks to you, then applying the SOAP process. Then, SOAK in God's presence with meditation and prayer.

Further study from this week's sermon.

Day 1: Read Genesis, chapters 1 and 2.

Day 2: Read Genesis, chapter 3.

Day 3 Read Luke 4:16-21; 5:12-16; 7:18-23.

Day 4: Read Acts 3:1-10; 4:8-14.

Day 5: Read 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24; 3 John 1:2.

Discussion questions for processing the sermon with your disciple buddy or small group. Why not grab someone and use these questions to discuss the sermon in the Gathering Center after church?

1. What was God's original intention for the health and well being of humans? What happened to change the condition of humans and the planet from health to disease ridden?
2. Describe how Jesus ministry on earth was a demonstration of God's intention to restore humans and conditions on the planet to His original intention?
3. Describe your understanding about the connection between a person's sin behavior, inner condition of anger, anxiety and/or lust — and that person's physical health.
4. Inner malfunctions are revealed in our thoughts. Analyze your thoughts for the past few days. Have you noticed thoughts of:
 - A. Accusations toward yourself or others?
 - B. Worries, scenarios of future pain or failure?
 - C. Pleasurable fantasies of inappropriate sexual behavior, having something someone else has or what you'd do with an unexpected windfall of money?Don't tolerate such thoughts, repent, redirect!
